

Uniform

Club shorts, black & white socks, boots. The Club will supply playing jerseys. Socks can be purchased from the club for \$20. If you have unwanted boots & would like to donate them to the club for resale, please bring them in before muster day.

Mouth guards

Every player will receive 2 mouth guards – 1 from the club and 1 provided by Waikato Rugby Union. These are to be worn at **all** practices and games – **NO** mouth guard and you will not be able to join in.

Fees

This year fees will be \$90 for one child and \$60 for every additional child from the same immediate family. Included in the fee is junior membership of the club, a club t-shirt, a pair of playing shorts and a mouth-guard. All players will be required to wear the correct shorts for games.
